Dinkelacker Oktoberfest (Marzen/Okttoberfest)

0.5 liters, abv. 5.7%

Enjoy Oktoberfest all year with this inviting medium-to-full body with aromas and flavors of fresh baked bread and cinnamon raisin toast. Experience a tingling, delightful, pepper jicama, candied lemon peels, and minerals finish that goes down perfectly.



Eggenberg Hopfenkönig Pils (Pilsner)

0.5 liters, abv. 5.1%

Crisp & Clean Pilsner that puts Bud Light to shame with high quality ingredients making this extremely easy to drink and very enjoyable. Kick it up a notch with this excellent pils brewed with the world-famous Saazer hops. The pinnacle of the Schloss Eggenberg brewery, this beer radiates a lightly golden gloss. Hopfenkönig has a crisp, clean, dry, hoppy nose and aromatic flavours that are sure to leave your palate satisfied.



Eggenberg Samichlaus Classic (Bock - Doppelbock)

0.25 liters, abv. 14%

Christmas is all about feeling jolly! What better way to be jolly than a delicious 14% beer called Samichlaus? Formerly known as the strongest and rarest beer in the world, this bad boy will even knock Santa off his sleigh. Samichlaus is aged for 10 months before even leaving Santa's workshop (aka the brewery) and is only brewed once a year. This Doppelbock is not to be taken lightly.



Weihenstephaner Vitus (Weizenbock)

0.5 liters, abv. 7.7%

Want a taste of the world's best beer? This light-colored, spicy single-bock gives off the fruity smell of dried apricots, joined by aromas of citrus, cloves, and hints of banana. It is full-bodied and sparkling to give your mouth a tingle. This noble, fruity beer does not disappoint.



Weihenstephaner Hefeweissbier (German Hefeweizen)

0.5 liters, abv. 5.4%

A beer so good that Blue Moon stole this ancient German recipe and brought it to America. Weihenstephan has been around since 1040 and is still kickin'. This golden-yellow wheat beer, with smells of cloves and a refreshing banana flavor goes excellently with our pretzel, Bavarian jalapeño cheddar sausage.



Schneider Aventinus (German wheat-doppelbock ale)

0.5 liters, abv. 8.2%

One of our most popular, it has been a top 20 beer for the past 30 years -- this beer is legit. Dive into this dark ruby Aventinus adventure with the aromas of ripe bananas, raisins, and plums that meet up with some roasted liquorice. A full-bodied and warming drink with a well-balanced, smooth finish. Goes hand-in-hand with a hearty sausage.



Rodenbach Rotating Sour (Flanders Red/Sour/Brown)

0.25 liters, abv varies

Rodenbach bears the proud title of "the most refreshing beer in the world" and is known worldwide for their sour beers. A blend of 75% young beer fermented in steel tanks and 25% old beer aged 2 year in large oak casks. It's so good we don't sell any other sour beer. Every week we keep a different one on draft so ask your bartender which one we currently have.

Delirium Tremens (Belgian Strong Ale)

0.25 liters, abv. 8.5%

This Belgian ale feels like the sound shot of alcohol is igniting your mouth. This truly unique golden coloured ale creates a bittersweet and spicy flavor. Warm your palate with a strong, long-lasting aftertaste. If you drink enough glasses, you may even start seeing pink elephants. Keep an eye out for the elephant at the bottom of your glass.

Delirium Red (Fruit Bier)

0.25 liters, abv. 8%

Enjoy Delirium Red's dark red colour and soft fruity aromas of almonds and sour cherries. It creates the perfect balance between sweet and sour that makes for an excellent dessert beer. Want to try something with a little less abv but still delicious? Ask about the Delirium Red and Grapefruit mix (aka the Panty Dropper).



Sion Kölsch (Kölsch)

0.5 liters, abv. 4.8%

In Germany, only beers brewed within the boundaries of Cologne, a city located at the Rhine river, are allowed to be sold as "Kölsch." Sion Kölsch is one of these beers: a light, crisp taste partnered with a slight herbal bitterness and sweet grainy pale malt.



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DAB Dortmunder (Dortmunder) - 0.5 liters, abv. 5%

Want to DABble in a fresh, pale brew of superior quality? This Dortmunder is the finest example of its kind. With a slim and elegant texture, it will sparkle in your mouth to create a full taste. It is a harmoniously balanced, crisp and easy-to-drink beer with gentle notes of hops and malt. Who doesn't love a good dab?



Tucher Helles Hefe Weizen (Weissbier - Hefeweizen) - 0.5 liters, abv. 5.2%

Drink beer how the Franconians like it. With the first sip, you experience a prickly lemon flavor with full bodied notes of banana and kiwi, followed by a long lasting tangy finish. This is a yeasty wheat beer made of Tucher's own "Sapienza" yeast and "Bagou" wheat malt together, partnered with bright barley malts that give this beer its aromatic yeast character.



Kasteel Tripel (Abbey Tripel) - 0.3 liters, abv. 11%

This beer will make you feel like royalty with a recipe that dates back to the Middle Ages. Oh, and did we mention it was brewed in an actual castle? This tripel is a strong blonde beer that is balanced but never too bitter. The bitterness and fruitiness of the hops make their presence felt. It has an aroma with touches of fruit and impressions of malt, cloves and flowers.



Straffe Hendrik Bruges Quadrupel (Abt/Quadrupel - Top 50) - 0.25 liters, abv. 11%

Get quadruple the taste with this rich and intensely dark beer. The aromas are zesty and elegant with hints of roast malt. You will taste coriander, dark fruits, and roasted chestnut with a slightly syrupy finish. Secondary fermentation in the bottle creates a living ale that will evolve over time.

Straffe Hendrik Bruges Tripel (Abbey Tripel) - 0.25 liters, abv. 9%

This classic beer is still brewed according to the original recipe. This beer boasts an amber-blond colour with an initial zesty and caramel taste with impressions of black pepper, coriander, ginger and orange. With a hoppy and malt-filled finish, sit back and enjoy this authentic Belgian Tripel.



Scaldis Pêche Mel (Fruit Beer) - 0.25 liters, abv. 8.5%

The Pêche Mel Scaldis was born as a popular student cocktail. Now, it is a combination of the Scaldis Ambrée and a peach beer. The Pêche Mel Scaldis has been brewed since 2009 by Brasserie Dubuisson. It is produced with the same care and attention as the other Scaldis beers, with its own original recipe containing natural peach extracts. The Pêche Mel Scaldis is highly recommended to lovers of fruit beers with character. The natural fruit aromas and extracts provide a beautiful harmony with the bitterness of the Scaldis Ambrée, creating a full-mouthed and completely balanced beer. The Pêche Mel Scaldis is a filtered, top-fermented beer with an alcohol volume of 8.5%. Without doubt, this is the strongest Belgian fruit beer.



HOFBRÄU

Hofbräu Original (Dortmunder/Helles) - 0.5 liters, abv. 5.1%

Beer lovers rejoice! This OG German beer will make you feel like you're in the heart of Munich with the golden colour and malty, yet slightly citrusy, taste. Toasty aromas of caramel and hops create a beer you could drink all day.



Hofbräu Munchen Dunkel (Dunkel/Tmavy) - 0.5 liters, abv. 5.5%

This dark beer has been around since 1589 and suits every occasion. Pouring a clear mahogany colour with a medium white head, the aromas give off caramel, fruit and toasted notes. This beer will satisfy your taste buds with its roasted, hoppy taste and subtle malty finish.

Schofferhofer Grapefruit (Radler/Shandy) - 0.5 liters, 2.5%

Need a light, refreshing, and fruity drink? This unique combination of grapefruit and unfiltered Hefeweizen creates a well-rounded taste. The tangy character with hints of sweetness will please your palates and leave you feeling refreshed.



Paulaner Oktoberfest Märzen (Märzen/Oktoberfest) - 0.5 liters, abv. 5.8%

Travel back in time with this amber beer style that was developed to celebrate the original Oktoberfest over 200 years ago. Out of all the 6 true Oktoberfest beers, we keep this one on tap for a reason. This masterful hop balance creates a full-bodied experience with rich malt flavor, dark toffee notes, and underlying fruitiness.



Progusta (German IPA) - 0.5 liters, abv. 6.8%

Jump into this hoppy battle between America and Germany with a beer any IPA drinker will love. This crisp, amber beer is the perfect combination of sweetness with a bitter note. The nose is full of sunny hops and becomes more complex as it sits. The taste is bitter but also sweet, with hints of fruit. The pleasant blend of the aftertaste will leave the flavors dancing in your mouth.



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
